POSITION SUMMARY

This position is responsible for assembling, testing, and troubleshooting instrumentation and control systems. The Instrument Technician ensures all equipment performs reliably and accurately to meet internal standards and customer specifications.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operate sandblasting equipment to clean and prepare a variety of metal parts and components
- Follow work orders, blueprints, and verbal instructions for part handling and blasting specifications
- Mask and protect areas of parts that should not be exposed to blasting
- Inspect surfaces for proper finish and report any defects or irregularities
- Maintain cleanliness and organization of sandblasting area
- Ensure blasting media is appropriate for the job and replenish materials as needed
- Perform minor maintenance on blasting equipment and report any mechanical issues
- Adhere to all safety procedures and proper use of personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Assist other departments when needed to support production flow
- Contribute to a team effort by accomplishing related tasks as required
- Perform all tasks in a safe and responsible manner
